1. ACTIVITIES AT HOME







Second language learners develop language proficiency in four areas:

- Reading
- Writing
- Listening

Various experiences in each of these areas will create a well-rounded language

Don't speak French Please don't worry!

- Your child's teacher will, offer content at a language level that your child will understand (or almost fully), and should be able to navigate.
- Tools such as Deep L can be used to translate content for the occasional tim your child may require assistance.

Tips for reinforcing language learning:

- A parent's attitude toward language learning is crucial to a child's success.
- Encourage your child to listen, read, or write in French every day.
- Break up the language learning into shor manageable chunks throughout the day.
- Encourage your child to speak with a sibling or a classmate in the target language.
- Point out how and where French is used in your daily life or the community.
